About 50% commercial impervious, about 40% wooded and about 10% open grassland

**BMPs in place:**

Vegetated buffering area all around pond. No other current BMPs, but in case of more development will have to maintain native buffers.

**Concerns of note:**

Large watershed, lots of impervious surface, close proximity to Shanahan pond's development.
