

Wetland management goal: To document wetland health as development occurs and to monitor long term effects of development on manmade lakes.

Types of disturbance (current or future land use impacts): This is a man-made lake to help stormwater runoff to relieve down stream flows to the Vermillion River.
Development to the north and west Lake Julia Park to the south and east.

Physical characteristics (landscape, habitat, significant features, etc.): Turf surrounding the lake up to buffer grasses.

BMPs in place: Wetland buffers.
